Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Basset Hounds 15 months of age and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number as a Basset Hound. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes..

Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

HANDLER WALK-THROUGH, TIMING AND WARM UP

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Electronic timing devices may be used.

MOVE UPS

Move-Up entries for Wednesday, October 2 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date of Wednesday, September 11 at 6:00 PM. MST. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to Wednesday, September 25, 2019 6:00 p.m. Move-up entries for Trial 2, October 2 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary, within 15 minutes of the conclusion of judging of each class at the trial site.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. There will be a VMO at this trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms. **Telephone, Telegraph, and Unsigned Entries** cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement & Rules attached to the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. **Entries received without fees will not be accepted.**

THE BASSET HOUND CLUB OF AMERICA WILL ASSESS A \$50.00 CHARGE, IN ADDITION TO ALL BANK FEES INCURRED, FOR ANY NSF CHECK OR ANY PAYMENT RETURNED FOR ANY REASON.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Express Mail entries must contain a signature waiver. No Refund for duplicate entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Forms: Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. Payment must accompany entry. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

All entry forms and payment checks that do not make the trial will shredded after the closing date unless otherwise requested.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform, all of the obstacles safely.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), guest(s), and children.

Any exhibitor whose dog(s), guest(s), and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. Parents are solely responsible for their children, and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety. No baby strollers in the show buildings.

UNENTERED DOGS MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW SITE.

PUPPIES UNDER FOUR MONTHS OF AGE ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM THE TRIAL GROUNDS.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season before these trials take place will be refunded provided the Trial Secretary receives notice from a veterinarian in writing prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial. A \$10.00/day entered recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, violent acts of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate.

No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site.

Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs. Failure to do so may, at the discretion of the event committee, result in being asked to leave the trial site in which case no refund of fees paid will be made.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Basset Hound Club of America (BHCA), their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to guests and/or children.

BHCA may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove, any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against BHCA or any official thereof.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The BHCA reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

No awards will be mailed.

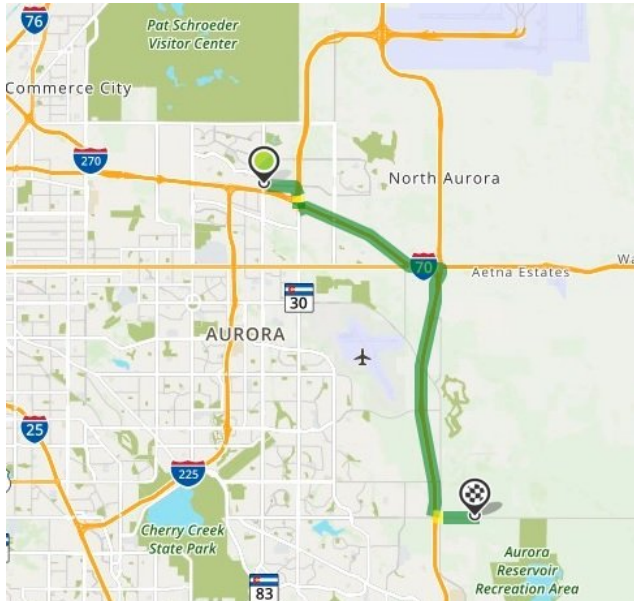

Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, Wednesday September 25. Move-up entries for Wednesday Oct. 2, Trial 2, must be delivered to the Trial Secretary, within 15 minutes of the conclusion of judging of each class at the trial site.

The request for moving-up must be made to the trial secretary according to the clubs published policy. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order, Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations For Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements.

A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class." After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (ie, Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
