A NILUSA 12" Logo plate will be awarded for each tracking qualifier at these tests.

Dogs must be kept on leash at all times.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION; With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be filed an original statement dated within one year & signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests, certifying that the dog is considered ready for such a test.

ENTRY FEE: \$80.00 – TD; TDU; \$120.00 – TDX, VST (in US dollars) This includes the 50 cent AKC recording fee & the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee.) Make checks **payable to BHCA** & send, with TD certification, if needed, to the Event Secretary, Ms. Sue Boyd, 5406 Barnwell Court, Leesburg, FL 34748-7889.

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is withdrawn from the test after the closing date, absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee, unless an alternate exhibitor is available & willing to take the spot of the exhibitor. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made, except as allowed in the Tracking Regs, Chapter 1, Section 11. Cancellation of entries must be made in writing or e-mail to the Test Secretary & must be received by the Secretary prior to the closing date. Entries sent by **OVERNIGHT DELIVERY** must be marked “no signature required”.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE under the conditions stated in the AKC Tracking Regs, Chapter 2, Section 8.

ON THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM write Type of Tracking Class in the “Obedience Trial Class” space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form & photocopies of forms without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

When the limit for each test has been reached, all remaining entries will comprise the alternate lists. Alternates have the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those that decline will have their entry fee returned. The test secretary will notify all entries of the draw results.

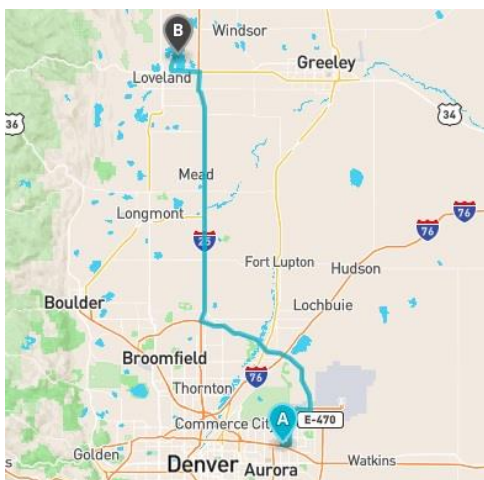

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (std, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, std).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered & shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record & dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.
