Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed. **ENTRIES CLOSE ON Wednesday September 8, 2021 at 6 PM Central Time** after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

CLASS ELIGIBILITY

Refer to Chapter 2, Section 2. Dogs may only be entered in classes for which they are eligible. Dogs that have previously earned the same or higher level AKC Scent Work titles may enter lower level classes.

Dogs are able to enter up to two (2) difficulty levels in each element, in each trial.

CLASS TRANSFER / MOVE UPS

Pre-trial class transfers must be received by 6:00 PM, CST, Monday September 27, 2021. AKC requires transfer requests be in writing. You may send email with subject line “Scent Work Class Transfer” to trial secretary. You must include: Dog’s registered name and AKC #, Class dog is entered in, which class the dog is to be transferred and which trials the transfer is to apply. Transfer will be acknowledged by return email.

Trial to Trial class transfers require a completed transfer form be turned into trial secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the current trial for subsequent trial(s).

ENTERING MORE THAN ONE DOG

Handlers may not handle more than one dog in each class with the exception of the Handler Discrimination classes. Multiple dogs for the same owner(s) may be entered in the same class provided the dogs are run by different handlers.

HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISON

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handler themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag, for the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. This fee and entry fee will need to be paid by cash or money order prior to the start of the first trial before entry will be considered valid.

Acknowledgments: Entries will be acknowledged after entries close, with acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. **If you provide an e-mail address on your entry you agree that judging programs and armband numbers may be sent to you via e-mail.** Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, contact the Trial Secretary.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

BHCA is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **10 entries per day** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to September 8, 2021 at 6 PM Central Time. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on September 8, 2021 at 6 PM Central Time. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

CHECK-IN, STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your armband number. Running order will be posted. The time and location for check-in will be published in the judging program.

Exhibitors MUST check-in for each trial in which they are entered as published in the Judging program.

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results. Crating and warm up areas will be posted. Exhibitors may need to crate in their vehicles.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each Element/Class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. **NO DOGS** are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A **warm-up area** will be available consisting of ONE marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and may also consist of blanks containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

Searches may be indoors, on tiled or dirt surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, dirt, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Outdoor areas may or may not be covered.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to visit the trial location to practice prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5, Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state “No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area”.

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search until the completion of the class.

Integrity of searches. If anyone is found to be discussing a search before classes have ended, all parties in the discussion will be penalized with a “not qualified” NQ for all classes entered that day, and will forfeit entry for subsequent days as well. For persons not entered, the Event Committee may ask those involved to leave.

Crating space may NOT be available in doors.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Photos and Videos. Exhibitors are welcome to photograph and/or video their own dogs either by another person or using a Go-Pro camera or the like as permitted by AKC. Exhibitors are encouraged to share their own dogs searching on social media and/or website upon completion of that day’s trials. No person should post photos or video of dogs they do not own without explicit permission from that dog’s owner. Judges may photograph and/or video searches they are judging for the purpose of their own education. Judges’ photos and/or videos may not be displayed or used for any purpose other than their own viewing without explicit permission of BHCA and the dog’s owners. Similar penalties as explained in the section “Integrity of Searches” may be imposed for violation of photo/video rules. Photographers authorized by BHCA to document its Nationals events may be present at these trials. You may decline their taking video or photos of you and/or your dog.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. BHCA and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. BHCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the BHCA or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times while on fairgrounds. Retractable leashes may not be used when on fairgrounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund (exception see 'Wait List'.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the first trial entered.

SEARCH STAGING

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the staging area when required.

Exhibitors must notify staging steward of conflicts should they need to run out of order.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.
