Hounds will be judged by the Rules used by the Basset Hound Club of America.

STAKES are LIMITED to a total of 15 entries each day.

Stakes may be run concurrently in two separate areas.

STAKES are LIMITED to 2 (two) Stakes per Owner/Household. Any additional stakes will be entered as Alternates, so please identify which stakes are your primary stakes if you have more than two.

In a BHCA sanctioned test, a Hunting Hound (HH), Senior Hunting Hound (SHH), Master Hunting Hound (MHH), or Master Hunting Hound Excellent (MHE) may be earned. Each entry must specify "Q" or "NQ" indicating whether or not that hound is intending to qualify for a title. Only one "Q" entry may be submitted for each hound at a test. A hound must earn 3 qualifying scores in solo, brace, or 2- coupled pack to earn an HH. Once having the HH, the hound must compete in one of the other remaining stakes for it's SHH, and then in the remaining stake to earn an MHH and MHE.

Hounds will be judged using the following categories of hunting ability: (1) ability to find game, (2) use of voice, (3) line ability, (4) adaptability, (5) determination each on a scale of 1 to 10; (6) gun shyness is judged on a pass/fail basis. In order to pass this test a hound must score at least 5 on each of the 5 categories and an average of 6 for all categories when all judge's scores are tallied. Handlers shall exhibit control of their hounds during testing.

Awards:

- Ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying hounds. For hounds completing 3 qualifying scores at each level a Rosette will be given and a title certificate with hound's name, owner's name, date will be mailed to all qualifying hounds.

Exhibitor Information:

- This test is open to hounds of the breeds specified that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained ILP or PAL numbers, except for aggressive hounds or hounds suffering from any deformity, injury or illness, which may affect the hound's physical or mental performance.
- Safety of the hounds is a primary concern. The test running grounds are open sage and grass meadows with Cedar tree groves. No releasing dogs on rabbits except as instructed by the judges during the trial. All hounds must be on leash at all times except when being tested. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their hounds, guests and children. Anyone engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the test committee, be asked to leave the trial site.
- Bitches in season are not permitted at this test and entry fee will be refunded if a bitch entered in solo stake is in season at time of test. If a bitch in season has been entered in a brace or pack another hound may be substituted. Refunds will be given if the secretary is notified by Wednesday, April 20, 2022.
- Judges are not required to wait for hounds. Owners or handlers of each hound are solely responsible for the dog being ready to perform.

- Please dress in layers and bring cold weather gear including sturdy waterproof boots. Please check the Cedar City weather before arrival. Bring plenty of water for dogs and human consumption as there is no running water at site. We will be on public land, 15 minutes from the nearest store. Bring your own everything. Bring your own lunch, snacks, water for you and your dogs.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I or we may otherwise have against the BHCA and RCKC and all approved judge(s) judging at these trials. I (we) agree that the club holding this test has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the clubs shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this test and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lesser of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the hunt test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
