Dogs must be present on the field trial grounds at the time of the drawing to be officially entered. OAAD & OAAB classes will run on consecutive days. Bitches in season are eligible to run in the OAAB class. The winners of all classes will run, if eligible, for absolute. The field trials will be held regardless of weather.

Practice is limited to ONE DOG at a time, per handler. If you are practicing with other dogs/handlers, do not allow dogs to “pack up” on a rabbit or surround brush piles. There will be a \$30.00 charge for any rabbit killed during training.
