The Kansas State University Veterinary Health Center Oncology Service and Basset Hound Club of America Health Committee have combined efforts to further evaluate cancers affecting AKC registered Basset Hounds living in the U.S. for all or most of their lives.

Sarah Broom, DVM, a member of the BHCA and BHCA Health & Research Committee, is currently pursuing a medical oncology residency at Kansas State University and helped design this study.

There is a strong need for more information regarding diagnosed cancers in purebred dogs, as this information is helpful for owners, breeders, and veterinarians. This information may aid in guiding breed-specific screening tests and perpetuate further genetic research regarding cancer in our beloved Bassets.
